Eligibility

Open to all Muscatine, IA area 4th and 5th Grade students in participating schools



School-Wide Prizes

Participating schools will hold and judge their own poster competitions. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place will be given for both 4th and 5th grade students. Medals will also be given to 20 students for each 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place positions.

School Level Awards for 4th & 5th Grade

- 1st Place: Solar Race Kit
- 2nd Place: Toy Wind Mill
- 3rd Place: Spinning Ball

Themes

- Posters should focus upon one or both of the following themes:
- Energy Conservation/Efficiency
 - The Replacement of Fossil Fuels with Renewable Energy Sources

Criteria for Judging

- Accuracy
- Creativity and Originality
- Color
- Effectiveness

(educating others about the importance of energy efficiency/conservation or renewable energy)

10 Best of School Medals will be awarded by MP&W, as well as 10 Plaques for Best of School

State Competition

Following the Regional Competition, MP&W will send all posters to the 2009 Iowa Energy Poster Competition, sponsored by the University of Northern Iowa, where they will be eligible to compete for state-wide awards. All posters will become the property of UNI.

Entry Requirements

One poster per student - Each student must create his or her own poster. Posters may be created in any medium. All entries must be submitted to the student's school by the date specified by the school.

Following school-wide competition, participating schools will submit their prize winning posters (and list of prize winners) to Muscatine Power and Water for Regional Competition no later than February 27, 2009.

Entries must be unfolded, with a label located on the back lower right corner. On the label, print or type: the student's name, grade level, school, teacher's name, principal's name, student's mailing address and home telephone number.
