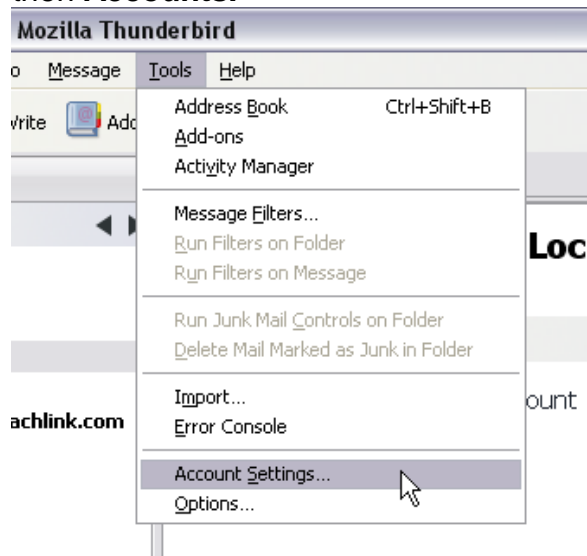
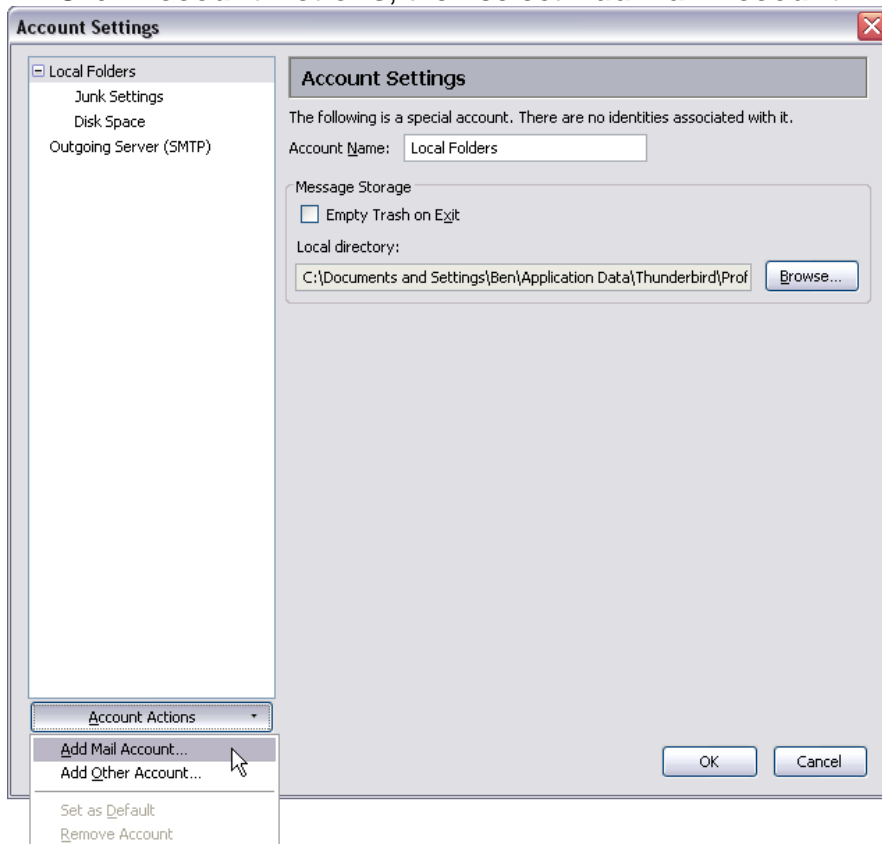


# Mozilla Thunderbird Setup


1. If you are already being asked which type of account you wish to set up then skip this step and the next. Otherwise, select **Tools**, then **Accounts**.



2. Click **Account Actions**, then select **Add Mail Account**.




3. Input the following information:


